



Wisconsin Futurity Horse Festival

September 16-19, 2020

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND RULES

- The Festival is closed to outside spectators and non-essential people are discouraged from attending the show.
- WAIVERS must be signed by all individuals on the grounds. Once signed, a green wristband will be given to that individual to be worn throughout the Festival. The waiver can be found at horsehowcalendar.com and wisconsinfuturity.com. Trainers will also have access to printed waivers to pre-sign before the Festival. Waivers and wristbands will also be available in the show office. WRISTBANDS WILL BE REQUIRED IN THE COLISEUM.
- MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED ON THE SHOWGROUNDS. Masks are not required when riding or driving a horse. Paper masks will be made available to anyone who does not have their own personal mask. We understand there may be persons unable to wear a mask due to certain medical conditions. Please refrain from harassing someone not wearing a mask, a slight reminder might be appreciated.
- SANITIZER will be available throughout the grounds. It is suggested that you utilize available sanitizer or bring your own and continue to wash hands frequently.
- RESTROOMS will be available at both the west and east end of the coliseum. Additional Park staff has been assigned to the restrooms for sanitation purposes. Restrooms in the Livestock Barn will be available including showers but may have limited hours. Please let show staff be aware of any bathroom areas that need attention.
- COLISEUM seating will be limited to the bleachers on the north side (hillside) of the coliseum. Masks and wristbands will be required. We ask that you social distance on the bleachers and care will be taken to not exceed the COVID-19 capacity limit. The bleachers are sanitized before each session. No sanitation is done on the south seating area of the coliseum.
- WARM UP AREA is limited to the rider/driver plus two attendants per entry. Please be considerate and allow the warmup area to be used by participants in the next two classes. When needed, ample time and/or holds will be provided between classes.
- RAIL use during a class is for trainers ONLY. Please distance 6 feet apart and remember that rail sanitation is only done before sessions. Masks are not required on the rail if for coaching and safety of the riders. Remember to re-mask upon leaving the coliseum.
- BARN AREAS are subject to social distancing and it is the responsibility of each stable owner/trainer to adhere to the guidelines and rules set for the show. Please take the time to disseminate the rules to your customers to help us have a safe and enjoyable show.
- OFFICE staff requires masks and social distancing. An area will be available for class change requests, class counts, class sheet binders, patterns, orders of go, etc. The photographer, Jon McCarthy will not have the usual viewing computers but will have proofs available on his website jonmccarthyphoto.com after each session.
